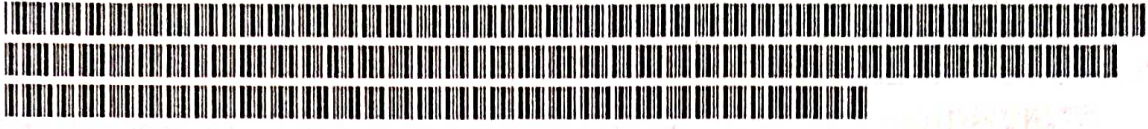

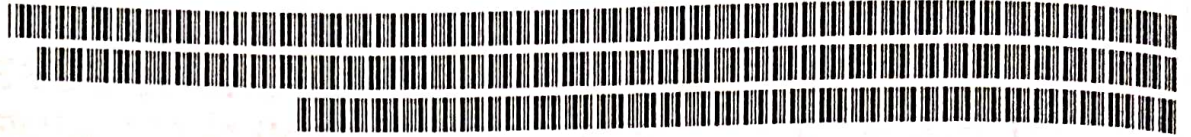

Rocks are solid natural masses of minerals. The top layer of the Earth's surface is made up of many different types of rocks. All rocks contain at least a single mineral. Rocks are just tons of grains of minerals that are stuck together.

Most of the rock found on the earth's surface initially formed underground, deep within the earth. Over thousands of years while the earth evolved to its present state, rocks were thrust upward to the surface where they were exposed to the weather. Rocks are also naturally occurring substances. However, they are not homogeneous, meaning they do not have a specific chemical composition. A rock can be a mixture of many mineral or mineraloid substances.

All rocks are composed of minerals which are natural inorganic (non-living) substances. Rocks are formed from the earth's minerals by the intense pressures within the earth. Sediment is any material that has eroded from existing rocks, is transported by water, wind, or ice, and deposited elsewhere. Limestone is a type of sedimentary rock that is made of the mineral calcite. They have organic matter such as fossils. There are many different ways to classify rocks. They are differentiated by their chemical structure, mineral composition, way of formation, or texture. There are three groups of rocks; sedimentary, igneous and metamorphic. An interesting fact about rocks is that they can be transformed into another type over time. This is because the chemical and physical characteristics of the rocks can change due to the environment. Unlike minerals, rocks do not have any nutritional benefits neither do they have a specific shape. The study of rocks is called petrology.

Biodegradable plastic from sugar cane also threatens the environment. Plastic made from cane sugar also threatens the environment. Researchers from the University of Gothenburg have found that perch change their behaviour when exposed to so-called bioplastic.

Traditional plastic, based on fossil oil, has flooded the earth and there is microplastic in all living things. This has led to intensive research for alternatives that decompose faster in nature. Bio-based polymers based on cane sugar are one such option. The most common bioplastic is poly-L-lactide (PLA), which is used in 3D printers, textiles, food packaging, disposable cutlery and other applications.

Bioplastics also have a negative impact on biological life. Doctoral student Azora König Kardgar at the University of Gothenburg has found that the behaviour of small perch exposed to bioplastics in fish food changed over a period of six months. They reacted far more when they met fellow perch than normal. In addition, there were signs of reduced movement, altered ability to form shoals and altered reaction when approached by danger.

“Toxicological experiments that analyse animal behaviour are very rare. Most commonly, researchers look at physiological changes. We can see that something in PLA plastic causes changes in the fish, but we can’t see what,” says Azora.

Because this research looked at PLA microplastic particles, the researchers also tested feeding the perch with kaolin particles, a white clay used for porcelain and to coat paper. Fish fed with kaolin showed some minor changes in behaviour. However, a male sex hormone was affected and some other gene expressions in the fish was curbed, such as the response to stress.

“We see that PLA is not harmless to fish, so it should not be sold as an environmentally friendly alternative to ordinary plastic. It should be considered as equivalent to ordinary plastic,” says Azora.

Cholesterol is a waxy substance that is present in our body. It's an important component of our cell walls and other tissues but it is thought to be harmful if in excess. It can lead to blockages caused by plaque formation in the heart's arteries causing heart disease and heart attacks. Such blockages can

also happen in arteries, in the legs or in the brain. Cholesterol is produced in the liver and the amount produced is influenced by our genes. The food we consume, too, has effect on cholesterol levels. Fatty foods, especially those high in saturated fats and foods high in simple sugars such as cold drinks increase cholesterol levels. Lack of physical activity and exercise also leads to elevated level.

We can reduce cholesterol levels by following heart-healthy lifestyle, which includes regular physical activity for at least 30 minutes daily and a diet high in fruits and vegetables and low in saturated sugar.

Statins are the group of drugs most recommended for those with high cholesterol. Red yeast rice has been shown to be effective in lowering cholesterol. Include garlic and flaxseed in your daily diet.

The ill-effects of high cholesterol take time to show, and you may not realise it until it is bit too late. Cholesterol by itself is important because it insulates nerve cells and membranes. Being a fatty substance, it does not dissolve in the blood and it is packaged into protein. There are good HDL cholesterol and bad LDL cholesterol. Bad cholesterol can stick to the smooth lining of the blood vessels, where it is absorbed, while HDL mops up excess bad cholesterol and removes it from blood vessels. Even moderate physical activity can help increase HDL cholesterol. Exercises such as walking, cycling, swimming, slow jogging, dancing etc. for 45 minutes, 3 times a week and anaerobic exercises will help increase good and reduce bad cholesterol.
